All prizes in each Grade/Class dependent upon entries

Conditions:

1. The TRA Inc. reserves the right to cancel or postpone the meeting, increase or decrease the number of trophies and adjust the programme as entries, circumstances and weather warrant.
2. Aggregate winners will be decided by shoot-off in the event of tied scores.
3. Competitors, on completion of shoot, will act as check scorer then scorer respectively.
4. Electronic targets will be used.
5. The Hunter-Tactical Class will be run under the draft NRAA rules. Muzzle brakes are permitted.
6. **NRAA Standard Shooting Rules (SSR's) apply at all times.**
7. **Safety Precautions**
 - a. Bolts may be in rifles only on the mound or during trigger testing as per SSRs.
 - b. Scorers must ensure shooters perform the vigorous cycling test of rifle actions before commencing the first round and sign the score card to signify whether the test has passed or failed. Failed tests must be brought to the attention of the Range Officer.
 - c. Scorers and check scorers must check that rifles are cleared before the shooter leaves the mound.
 - d. The onus of safety is on the shooter and scorers.
